Quota USA Unified Service Project

The year 2020 has been one of great challenges. Due to COVID19 safety measures, many people have been furloughed or let go from their jobs, resulting in a great need for compassion and material resources across the country.

Boxes of Hope is a unified service project that individual Quota USA clubs can utilize to meet their communities' needs by coordinating material donations.

This project will give Quota USA clubs an opportunity to give back and further the **Quota USA** mission of building and strengthening our communities by expanding opportunities and resources for our citizens.

The Boxes of Hope project is easy to execute and can fit any budget.

- Empower the service committee to find out what would give local families hope, such as food items, toiletries, school supplies, etc.
- Determine a budget that the club can afford.
- Select families to serve by contacting community agencies or looking at projects that the clubs have done in the past which have identified families in need.
- Purchase the items and place them in a box wrapped in green paper with a label that
 identifies the Box of Hope from Quota USA. (Order Quota USA branded labels at
 https://www.zazzle.com/store/quotausa/products.)
- Add a personal touch by including a personal note from the participating club. The
 message should inspire hope by letting the recipient know that someone cares about
 them.
- Club Members deliver the boxes to the selected recipients and take photos to post to Facebook, Instagram, club website, etc.

There is no time frame for this project, but December through January is suggested.
